Blackboard™ Blackboard and CourseCompass

- **Blackboard™**
 - ✓ Used for most online and distance learning courses with the exception of math courses (see CourseCompass below).
 - ✓ 24/7 Online Support Center www.ccsnh.edu/distancelearning/index.htm.
 - ✓ Log in to your Blackboard account 48 hours after registering.

User name: First initial of your first name, last name and the last five (5) digits of your social security number or generated ID if you are not using your SSN (username = all lower case, no spaces, no commas). *Example user name:* jsmith56789 (John Smith, SSN 123-45-6789). **Password:** The last six (6) digits of your social security number or generated ID number if you are not using your SSN. *Example password:* 456789 (John Smith, SSN 123-45-6789)

 - ✓ Used for all online math courses.
 - ✓ Obtain log in information from your professor at the start of class.
